RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board desires to further develop the County's Economy and in all ways otherwise enhance the standard of living for its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Tazewell County Planning Commission has recommended acceptance of Sable Lane into the County Road system;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tazewell County Board of Supervisors hereby accepts *Sable Lane*, adjoining U.S. Route 460 West, lying to the North in the Springville/ Shannon Dale area of the County of Tazewell, west of the Town of Bluefield, Virginia, bounded by the properties of Gibson, Smith, Buckland, and Pruitt, for a distance not to exceed _____ feet, along the course as shown on the attached map.

It is further resolved that the Board's acceptance is conditioned upon approval of the right of way by the County Attorney and all other qualifications set forth in the County's Orphan Road Ordinance.
